Contact:	A letter will be sent to the preacher 10 days before the service, usually by email, with details of Steward and Organist on duty. Hymns should be notified to the organist.
Other:	A screen, projector and laptop can be available with sufficient notice.

Books: Singing the Faith (preferred), Songs of Fellowship (combined). Hymns can be projected by arrangement, given sufficient notice. Methodist Worship Book.

Other:	There is a Loop System for those with hearing difficulties. Preachers are asked to speak near the microphones, please – there are two (one at the pulpit, the other at the lectern).
